

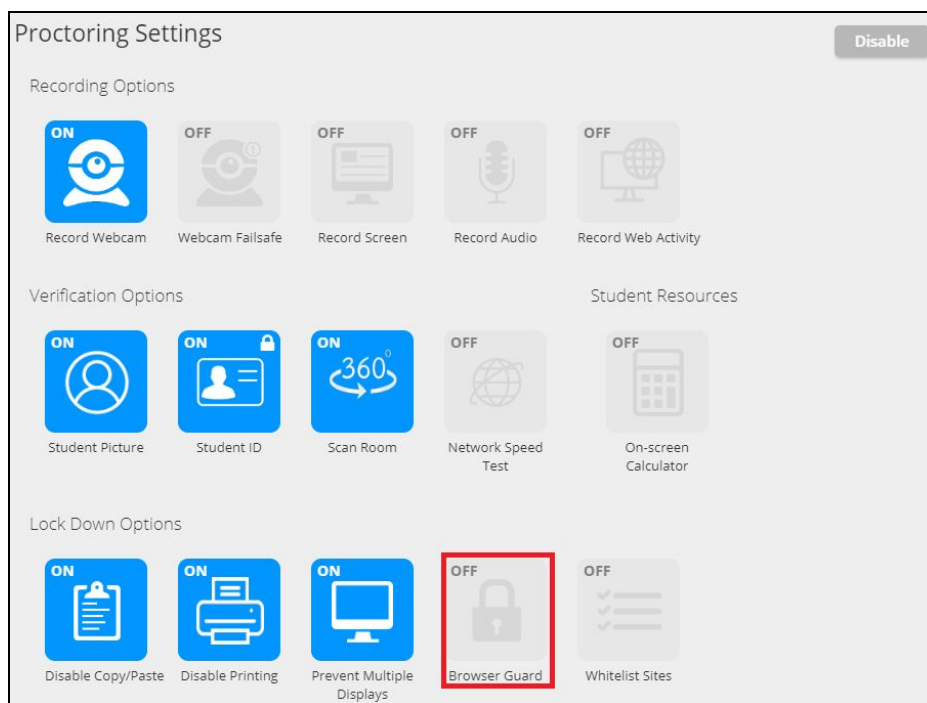
Using Honorlock With Exemplify

In order to use Honorlock with Exemplify, certain settings need to be configured on both platforms to ensure compatibility:

- Exemplify - During the creation of the exam on Exemplify, the security setting that ensures compatibility is “Non-Secure.” This will grant the student access to their desktop applications as well as internet capabilities. This is a key component for Honorlock to function.

- Once the Exemplify exam is created with the above settings, the Honorlock exam can now be created.

- The one setting that needs to be disabled is “Browser Guard.” Leaving this feature off will allow students to leave their browser window after proctoring has started. This setting is by default disabled, but it is always recommended to double check before enabling Honorlock. Below is an example of the proctoring window:



Note: As always, this window can be accessed through the Honorlock Tab of your LMS. Once you have ensured this setting is off, the settings can be saved, and students will be able to take their exam!
